## Waco Mammoth National Monument

*Allow 45 mins to tour, 20 mins driving and loading  
6220 Steinbeck Bend*

*"The nation's first and only recorded discovery of a nursery herd of Pleistocene mammoths." - National Park Service.*

## Dr Pepper Museum & Free Enterprise Institute

*Allow 1 hour to tour, 20 mins driving and loading  
300 S. 5th*

Enjoy a little "pop" culture and learn about one of America's favorite soft drinks. Numerous interactive exhibits add to the fun. After, enjoy a cold Dr Pepper float inside the restored turn-of-the-century soda fountain.

## Mayborn Museum Complex

*Allow 1.5 hours to tour
