Temperature (°F)

The climate of Waco is humid subtropical with hot summers. Annual precipitation ranges from 20 to 50 inches, typically favoring a **wet spring/fall** and **dry summer/winter**.

Winters are generally mild with considerable temperature variability. Periodic cold fronts may bring brief spells of below normal temperatures. Wintry precipitation is infrequent, and snow occurs about every other winter.

During the peak summer months of **July** and **August**, daytime temperatures are consistently in the 90s, often reaching 100 degrees or higher. Gulf moisture maintains stifling humidity, and brief late day thunderstorms are common.

Spring and **fall** are typically the wettest seasons, but the bulk of the rainfall is associated with fast-moving, late day thunderstorms.
